### **PLOT**

East elevated plot with a slight slant caused by a sandstone bed. Protected from the north by a stone hill and fig trees. #### **HARVEST**

Hand-picked in 12 kg cases.

#### **WINEMAKING**

Destemmed, both alcoholic and malolactic fermentations take place in 1,000 l. stainless steel vats. The wine is then aged in used and new French-oak barrels for only 9 months in order to preserve the delicate notes and exceptional character.

#### **TASTING NOTES**

Intense and vibrant red fruit -raspberries, red currant combined with a bright zesty acidity. To finish it off, the spectacular floral nose floats above it all.
