OAK AND AGING TREATMENT

Barrel aging: Malolactic in new barrels (50% French & 50% American oak) followed by a further 8 months before bottling.

TASTING NOTES

Color:

cherry red with ruby edge medium layer, clean and bright.

On the nose:

very intense with a pleasant bouquet of balsamic notes: almonds, chocolate, vanilla and terrified aromas that give way to notes of confit fruit.

On the palate:

good structure, balanced, pleasant acidity, soft tannins round leaving a long and complex aftertaste.
