GRAPE VARIETY

90% Tempranillo, 10% Mazuelo, Graciano y Garnacho

WINEMAKING

Crafted from our oldest vineyards, over 40 years old, with limited yields. It is only produced in vintages rated as excellent or very good, with each release numbered. In the pursuit of excellence, the barrels are carefully selected for their exceptional finesse and quality — a combination of French and American oak.

TASTING NOTES



On the nose; fresh and ripe red and black fruits, very well integrated with spicy black pepper, cocoa, forest floor and balsamic.



On the palate; powerful, fully marks the mouth, mature but with very good evolution in the bottle. It has a classic profile of Rioja wines with full maturity of the grapes. A wine that will give joy in the bottle and ages well with time.
