2021 VINTAGE.

After a dry spring and several hailstorms in June, the year will be remembered for its mild summer, with cool night temperatures: “like in the old days”. These conditions brought wonderful grapes of a touching quality.

VINTAGE CLASSIFICATIONS.

- DOCa Rioja: Very good.
- Álava Viticulture and Oenology Department: Excellent.

VARIETIES.

95% tempranillo, 5% graciano.

VINEYARD. Grapes selected in chosen areas in different plots: Las Anchas, Lentisco and Central. Average age: 77 years old.

WINEMAKING. After fermentation, it was aged for 22 months in new French oak barrels. It was bottled in August 2023. Aged in bottle for more than one year.

TASTING NOTES. Deeply aromatic, with an attractive airy sensation and a harmonious combination of notes, ranging from subtle flowers to black fruits: blackberries, *picota* cherries.

Intense and expressive palate. Great balance, a reflect of the order and well-being of a well-tended vineyard. Vibrant tannins in a lively, stimulating body, where we can feel fluidity and the touch of the river breezes as well as the deep minerality that underlies the alluvial clays.

In the end, a fresh, clear, timeless elegance persists, like an image of the evening sunlight over the old country paths. And it still has a great potential to offer.
